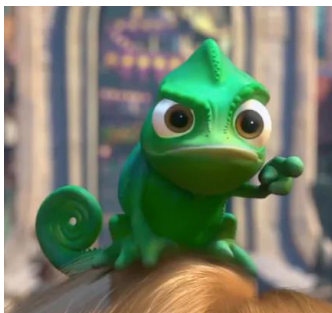

## Lodging

Rooms are available Thursday PM through Sunday AM. Wednesday Night Lodging is available **only upon approval** from the Supreme Deputy. Each room night is paid separately dependent on how many people are sharing a room that night.

To the best of their ability, NH Grand Assembly will assign rooms as close to the Rooming list provided as possible. If there is any room that is not filled, and you wish to have it filled with someone from another assembly, please mark this clearly on the Registration form. If you only designate 2 -3 persons in your room, you will be required to pay the difference if the room cannot be filled.

**Check-in time** is on Friday at 3pm. Some rooms may be ready for occupancy beforehand. Please check at the Grand Assembly Registration Desk (outside of Grand Assembly Room) for your room keys. Mother Advisors are asked to pick up their Assemblies keys/registration packets as a group. If you are not able to be present Friday afternoon, please designate one adult who will be in charge of picking up your assembly packet.

**IMPORTANT:** Check -out time on Sunday is at 11am. Each Assembly must have adults check each room as it is vacated Sunday to be sure all personal items are removed and that the room is left in good condition. If anyone knows that they will not be able to check out by 11am, please notify the Registration Committee so that we might have an extension of the check-out time for that room.
